Thank you to everyone who engaged with our latest community survey about our **optional uniform** that will be available for our students for the start of next year. We are very excited with the results and to now share them with you (see page 2)! Our School Board has very generously budgeted to purchase a t-shirt/sports top for every child who is enrolled at the start of Term 1, 2024. This will mean that when we attend events or go on excursions we can all wear these. ProBrands will also send through information about how you can order other uniform items such as hoodies, shorts etc directly from their website. While the vast majority of parents did want the option of uniform to be available, it is not compulsory for students to wear this at school each day.

This Friday we will be sending home 'end of year reports' which are a summary of your child's/children's learning and progress this year. Uniform Hoodie - all black with red accent *


UNIFORM SURVEY RESULTS

Front Back




Uniform Top Red/Black with Teal accent
